Hello Sherwood Family,

This week Sherwood will have adjusted bell schedules to accommodate required testing on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

On Wednesday, October 13, 2021, MCPS will administer the PSAT to all 10th and 11th grade students free of charge. SHS will also be administering the SAT to any 12th grade student who was not able to take the SAT last spring. Due to the large number of students testing we will not be administering the PSAT to our 9th grade students. Please note the following:

- Students who are not participating in the PSAT/SAT testing are not required to attend school until 11:40 am.
- Buses will arrive and depart from school at normal times.
- Students that ride the bus in the morning will be assigned to an alternate location for supervision until lunch begins at 11:40 am.
- We will be having 15 minute class check-ins for the afternoon classes.

Please see the bell schedule for Wednesday, October 13 below.

On Thursday and Friday, Sherwood will be administering the MCAP. In order to properly complete all the testing in the window that we received from the state, we will be running a 2-hour testing block Thursday and Friday mornings with periods 1-8 and lunch following the morning testing block.

- THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14: MCAP ELA TESTING-session 2 for **all** 9th and 11th grade students
- FRIDAY, OCTOBER 15: MAP-M TESTING, HS MISA Makeups

This year because of county health provisions, the homecoming dance will take place **outside** in the school stadium. The dance is Saturday, October 23, from 7 pm - 10 pm. Ticket sales for homecoming begin on Monday during lunch.
