STUDENT SERVICE-LEARNING HOURS (SSL)

MCPS requires all students to meet their SSL hour requirements for graduation. This means, you need to have a total of 75 hours to graduate in June. There are many opportunities available to students.

AP Exam Payment and Fee Waiver Deadlines Reminder

- To pay online, go online to Watkins Mill High School website. Scroll down (on the left) to "School Cash On-line". Register for "School Cash On-line. You will get an email with detailed instructions. Follow the instructions and make the payment online. A 3.75% fee will be added to the purchase price of a school purchase as a site service fee. This fee is not collected by MCPS but is a processing fee of the company hosting site. If you have filled out the Waiver form, then please only pay for the 16\$ exam fee.
- To pay by check, make checks/money orders payable Watkins MIll High School and include your student's name and ID number in the subject line. Send your payment to Lisa Holderman at 10301 Apple Ridge Rd, Gaithersburg, MD 20879. Give it to Mrs. Holderman in the Financial Office.
- If your family needs support in paying for some or whole exam fee, please fill out the Title IV Scholarship Form

If your family has filled out the waiver form, please pay the \$16 for EACH exam. If your family has not filled out the waiver form, please pay \$101 for EACH exam that your student is taking.
