Subject: Student Parking

Students parking is by permit only and located in the lot by the stadium. **Parking permits are valid for one semester only and are sold only in September and January.** This will be students' only chance to purchase a permit until the following semester. Applications for parking permits are available on the school website and in the Business Office.

Parking permits will be issued in the order that the completed applications are received. Once a permit is issued, the fee is non-refundable. Once sold out, remaining applicants will be refunded, and there will be no waiting list or options for purchase until the beginning of the following semester.

September 2 and 3, 2021: Applications accepted from SENIORS ONLY

September 8 and 9, 2021: Applications accepted from JUNIORS AND SENIORS

September 10, 2021: Parking permits will be available for pickup in the Financial Office

September 13, 2021: Parking enforcement begins.

Parking is a privilege. That privilege may be revoked for disciplinary reasons at the school's discretion. Illegally parked vehicles are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

Parking Regulations: Permit holders who violate any of these regulations will have their permit suspended or revoked.

1. Permit holders must comply with all established traffic rules in the parking area. These are: Use only the marked entrance and exit for the parking area; follow the traffic flow - one way toward exit not the roadway where buses are parked for picking up and discharging students; and park only in the designated student parking areas.
2. Once a permit is issued, a student car may park any space in the back to the right of the stadium. Do not park along the fence to the right of the driveway. These spaces are assigned specifically to members of the faculty and staff. Do not park in unlined areas.

3. Speed, while on campus, must not exceed 10 miles per hour.
4. Use of a car as a social gathering place is strictly prohibited.
5. The administration reserves the right to inspect cars parked on school grounds when there is reasonable suspicion that they may contain prohibited items.
6. Any car parked on campus without an appropriate permit may be towed and/or ticketed. School disciplinary action may also be taken against the owner/driver of the vehicle. Please refer to the student agenda for specific consequences.
7. Any student car parked in a staff space or in an unauthorized space may be towed and/or ticketed. School disciplinary action may also be taken against the owner/driver of the vehicle. Please refer to the student agenda for specific consequences.
8. A student who loses his/her parking permit will be required to fill out a new application and reapply for the permit. There will be a re-issuance fee of \$37.50. This also applies if the permit is stolen from your vehicle.
9. Car trouble is not an excused tardy nor an excused absence from school.

Students who leave school grounds during the day in an automobile will have their parking privileges suspended or revoked. Application fees will not be refunded.

Students who fail to follow the safety rules will have their parking permits revoked. Application fees will not be refunded.
