THE SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Rockville High School is located in suburban Washington, DC, in Rockville Maryland. Rockville is a residential community of about 50,000. Rockville High School is an ethnically diverse comprehensive high school with grades 9, 10, 11, 12. The school was established in 1968 and is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and by the Maryland State Department of Education.

School programs include the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, International Baccalaureate Career Program, Advanced Placement Program, and Project Lead the Way Program.

In March 2020 Montgomery County Public Schools moved to a distance-learning model of instruction for the remainder of the semester. At that time, baseline grades were established and from that point, grades could only be improved. At the end of the semester, students were given the option to earn a pass or a letter grade, no option for failure. MCPS does not administer final exams in any subject. Semester 1 of the 2020-2021 school year, will begin in the distance learning model, letter grades will be earned.
