Khám Sức Khỏe Trước Khi Tham Gia Thể Thao

Kính gởi Quý vị Phụ huynh hay Giám hộ:

Học sinh học từ lớp 9 đến 12 bắt buộc phải khám sức khỏe mỗi năm trước khi tham gia vào chương trình thể thao liên trường và chương trình tại trường MCPS. Học sinh lớp 7 và 8 phải khám sức khỏe mỗi hai năm để được tham dự vào chương trình thể thao liên trường tại trường trung học cấp hai của MCPS.

Kiểm tra sức khỏe sẽ được người cung cấp dịch vụ y tế có thẩm quyền thực hiện.

Việc kiểm tra sức khỏe trước khi tham dự bao gồm 4 phần: Đơn Lịch sử (trang 1 và 2), Đơn Kiểm tra Sức khỏe (trang 3), Đơn Lực Sĩ với Khuyết Tật: Bổ sung cho Lịch sử Lực Sĩ (trang 4), và Đơn Đủ Điều Kiện Y Tế (trang 5).

Học sinh chỉ phải nộp trang cuối cùng (MEDICAL ELIGIBILITY FORM- Đơn Đủ Điều Kiện Sức Khỏe, trang 5) cho nhà trường hay huấn luyện viên trước khi tham dự. Người cung cấp dịch vụ sức khỏe có thẩm quyền nên giữ lại bốn trang đầu tiên.

Nếu một học sinh-lực sĩ trải nghiệm một chấn thương, bệnh tật hoặc giải phẩu đáng kể sau khi nạp bản khám sức khỏe mỗi năm trước khi tham gia vào chương trình thể thao, cần có thư thông báo từ người cung cấp dịch vụ sức khỏe có thẩm quyền để tiếp tục tham gia.

Những tin tức về sức khỏe nộp cho trường chỉ có những nhân viên về sức khỏe và giáo dục liên hệ tới con em quý vị mới được xem.

Trường hợp ngoại lệ không phải khám sức khỏe được cho phép nếu việc này trái với tín ngưỡng của học sinh. Trong những trường hợp này, gia đình nên gửi đơn chứng nhận.

Nếu em học sinh-lực sĩ cần thuốc và/hay một điều trị được thi hành tại trường học hay trong khi thực tập hay các sự kiện thể thao, quý vị phải yêu cầu một người cung cấp dịch vụ y tế có thẩm quyền hoàn tất một mẫu đơn cho uống thuốc và/hay điều trị cho mỗi loại thuốc và hay điều trị cần được thi hành.
