Subject: Staff Appreciation (FMC-09-16-19-08)

Question

Ms. Dixon requested that staff provide information on how the MCPS guideline on staff appreciation limit is received by schools and whether it provides schools with enough discretion to make independent decisions.

Response

Schools receive a memorandum each school year that provides guidance for using the Independent Activity Fund for staff appreciation and refreshment expenditures in the upcoming year. The amount authorized for each school is calculated by multiplying \$60 by the number of staff members assigned to the school. The staff count is obtained from the Lawson Human Resources Information System on October 31 and is communicated in early November to schools. Exceptions for the spending limit may be requested using Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Form 281-55, Restricted Independent Activity Fund Purchases: Request for the Chief Financial Officer's Approval.

My September 26, 2018, memorandum to the Board of Education provided a brief chronology of how the staff appreciation and meeting refreshments guidelines have changed throughout the years (Attachment A). In 2002, the annual spending limit on staff appreciation or refreshment expenditures from the school's Independent Activity Fund was adjusted to a base of \$2,000 for elementary schools, \$3,000 for middle schools, and \$4,000 for high schools. Alternatively, schools could calculate their spending limit at \$35 per staff member. In 2008, the protocol was changed, authorizing \$45 per Full-time Equivalent (FTE) staff member. In 2012, the amount per FTE staff member further was increased to \$60 per FTE. Finally, in 2017, the protocol was revised again to change the limit from \$60 per FTE to \$60 per individual staff member.

My memorandum also explained that in Fiscal Year 2018, the 204 schools had been authorized to spend \$1,199,640 on staff recognition and refreshments. Of that amount, \$786,522, or 65.6 percent of the authorization was expended by the schools. A total of 183 schools spent at or less than the spending authorization. In 2019, 205 schools were authorized to spend \$1,214,280 on staff recognition and refreshments. Of that amount, \$839,546, or 69.1 percent of the authorization was expended by the schools. Of the 205 schools, 195 schools spent at or less than the authorized amount.

More recently, my memorandum of January 23, 2019, provided an update to the Board based on a survey of school principals that was conducted by the Internal Audit Unit staff (Attachment B). In terms of what changes should be made, the principals who responded to the survey indicated that MCPS should identify additional sources of funds for staff appreciation expenditures and/or allow more flexibility in the type of funds that can be used. Data from the previous years combined with the survey results pointed to the issue of equity. While schools would like to be able to spend more on teacher appreciation, they did not have the funds to do so. Increasing the staff appreciation limit would result in schools with access to additional funds being able to spend more while schools without access would not.

The dilemma is that to address the inequity of availability of funding, we have to create opportunity for those schools that do not have access to considerable revenue from outside sources to have more funding to cover these expenditures. If it is the interest of the Board to increase the amount per employee, there needs to be increased access to funding. Otherwise, increasing the amount per employee only will create additional inequity. Therefore, the first step in the process is to identify practices that would make more funds available to schools and then, following that, possibly increasing the amount per employee.

As noted in my January 23, 2019, memorandum, we convened a work group of principals, central services staff, school business administrators and various school staff, and representatives from the Montgomery County Council of Parent Teacher Associations, Inc. The charge of the work group was to study the equitable availability of Independent Activity Fund resources. Work group members identified four areas of study for solutions. One was to create a central fund for funds to be distributed to highly impacted schools and schools with an identified need. Outside groups raising funds for Independent Activity Funds would be asked to voluntarily contribute to the fund. Additionally, MCPS will review existing fund raising and end-of-year funds for opportunity to support the central fund after a plan is in place. Once we have increased the availability of funds, MCPS will study whether limits on spending for staff appreciation should be increased.

Questions have been raised as to whether operating funds can be allocated to fund staff appreciation. MCPS has not allocated operating funds to be used in schools for staff recognition expenditures. It would require \$1,380,000 to be budgeted in the operating budget for staff recognition of approximately 23,000 employees. We surveyed two area school districts to determine if they use their operating budget to fund staff recognition. Both Anne Arundel County Public Schools and the Howard County Public School System do not use their operating

budget for these expenditures. We are gathering additional data from other Maryland districts and seeking guidance on state policy that may impact our ability to do so. When this additional information is obtained and reviewed, I will provide you with a recommendation for changes, if appropriate.

Subject: Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshments Update

Question

Ms. Dixon requested a follow-up on need to increase amount principals can spend on staff appreciation.

Response

My memorandum dated February 7, 2018, Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshment Update (FMC-01-08-18-04), provided information related to the evolution of the guidelines for annual spending amounts authorized for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments and next steps to gather school principal input for potential amendment to these guidelines.

The following is a brief chronological summary of the staff appreciation and meeting refreshments spending guidelines.

- In 2001, the aggregate annual spending limit for staff refreshments was established at \$1,200 per elementary school and \$3,000 per secondary school.
- In 2002, the annual spending limit was adjusted to a base amount of \$2,000 per elementary school, \$3,000 per middle school, and \$4,000 per high school, or schools could calculate their spending limit at \$35 per staff member to spend beyond the base amount.
- The August 4, 2008, memorandum, *Independent Activity Fund Committee Report*, from the chief operating officer, increased the annual aggregate spending authorized for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments to \$45 per Full-time Equivalent (FTE).
- The April 16, 2012, memorandum, *Revised Guidelines for Independent Activity Fund Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshment Expenditures*, from the chief operating officer, increased the annual spending limit from \$45 to \$60 per FTE.
- The August 31, 2017, memorandum, *New Process for Calculating Staff Appreciation and Refreshment Spending Limit*, from the chief financial officer, changed the calculation of the annual amount from \$60 per FTE to \$60 per individual staff member effective Fiscal Year (FY) 2018.

An analysis of the FY 2018 expenditures for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments follows. School principals are able to request an exception to the spending limits for staff appreciation

and meeting refreshments, and schools typically are authorized to spend beyond these established guidelines when justifiable reasons and a spending plan are provided.

- In FY 2018, the total authorized for 204 schools to spend for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments for FY 2018 was \$1,199,640. Of that amount, \$786,522, or 65.6 percent was expended.
- The number of schools staying within their authorized spending allowance was 183 or 89.7 percent, while 21 or 10.3 percent exceeded their allowance. Of those schools that exceeded their allowance, eight received written authorization to do so.
- The following table illustrates the average spending limit and actual per person spending by school level for FY 2018.

To expand this analysis, I recommended in my February 7, 2018, memorandum that staff survey school principals after FY 2018 to gather feedback on the changes to the staff appreciation guidelines. With school opening now behind us, staff in the Internal Audit Unit will conduct this survey of principals in October 2018. The purpose of this survey is to gather feedback as to the adequacy of the current guideline calculation amount and any suggested amendments thereto. I will provide the Board an update on the results of this survey, as well as any recommendations on whether to adjust the guidelines for FY 2020.




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

Subject:

Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshments Update

In my memorandum dated September 26, 2018, I provided the Board staff appreciation and meeting refreshment information as a follow up to a request from Board Member Jeanette Dixon (Attachment A). As noted in my memorandum, effective Fiscal Year (FY) 2018, the calculation of the annual amount principals were allowed to spend for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments was changed from \$60 per Full-time Equivalent to \$60 per individual staff member. To expand our analysis of FY 2018 expenditures for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments, I indicated that staff in the Internal Audit Unit would conduct a survey of principals to gather feedback as to the adequacy of the current guideline calculation amount and any suggested amendments thereto. The Internal Audit Unit conducted an online anonymous survey of principals from October 18, 2018, through November 9, 2018, to gather feedback on the change to the staff appreciation guidelines. This memorandum provides a summary of the feedback gathered through this survey and an overview of next steps related to this work.

Summary of Feedback

Of the 206 schools, a total of 113 or 54.6 percent of the principals responded to the survey. Results of the survey are provided in Attachment B. Key survey questions and responses follow.

- Does your school have sufficient Independent Activity Fund (IAF) general funds to expend \$60 per person for staff appreciation/refreshments each year?
 - Sixty principals or 53.1 percent of the respondents indicated that they did have sufficient funds.
- Does the current \$60 per person spending guideline allow sufficient flexibility to provide staff appreciation/refreshments for your staff?
 - o Sixty-nine principals or 61.1 percent of the respondents indicated that they did have sufficient flexibility.

What changes should be made?

- Find other additional sources of funds.
- o Allow more flexibility in the type of funds that can be used.

Given this most recent feedback, coupled with the Fiscal Management Committee's recent review of cell tower revenue and disbursements, as well as other ongoing discussions many of us have been having with Montgomery County Council of Parent Teacher Associations, Inc. members and school communities about equity, I have asked staff to convene a work group to study equitable availability of IAF revenue. The discussions will include, but not be limited to, staff appreciation and meeting refreshments, field trip funding, cell tower revenues, and fund raising. I have asked that this work group report its findings and recommendations to the Board's Fiscal Management Committee at its May 2019 meeting.

Subject: Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshments Update

Question

Ms. Dixon requested a follow-up on need to increase amount principals can spend on staff appreciation.

Response

My memorandum dated February 7, 2018, Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshment Update (FMC-01-08-18-04), provided information related to the evolution of the guidelines for annual spending amounts authorized for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments and next steps to gather school principal input for potential amendment to these guidelines.

The following is a brief chronological summary of the staff appreciation and meeting refreshments spending guidelines.

- In 2001, the aggregate annual spending limit for staff refreshments was established at \$1,200 per elementary school and \$3,000 per secondary school.
- In 2002, the annual spending limit was adjusted to a base amount of \$2,000 per elementary school, \$3,000 per middle school, and \$4,000 per high school, or schools could calculate their spending limit at \$35 per staff member to spend beyond the base amount.
- The August 4, 2008, memorandum, *Independent Activity Fund Committee Report*, from the chief operating officer, increased the annual aggregate spending authorized for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments to \$45 per Full-time Equivalent (FTE).
- The April 16, 2012, memorandum, *Revised Guidelines for Independent Activity Fund Staff Appreciation and Meeting Refreshment Expenditures*, from the chief operating officer, increased the annual spending limit from \$45 to \$60 per FTE.
- The August 31, 2017, memorandum, *New Process for Calculating Staff Appreciation and Refreshment Spending Limit,* from the chief financial officer, changed the calculation of the annual amount from \$60 per FTE to \$60 per individual staff member effective Fiscal Year (FY) 2018.

An analysis of the FY 2018 expenditures for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments follows. School principals are able to request an exception to the spending limits for staff appreciation

and meeting refreshments, and schools typically are authorized to spend beyond these established guidelines when justifiable reasons and a spending plan are provided.

- In FY 2018, the total authorized for 204 schools to spend for staff appreciation and meeting refreshments for FY 2018 was \$1,199,640. Of that amount, \$786,522, or 65.6 percent was expended.
- The number of schools staying within their authorized spending allowance was 183 or 89.7 percent, while 21 or 10.3 percent exceeded their allowance. Of those schools that exceeded their allowance, eight received written authorization to do so.
- The following table illustrates the average spending limit and actual per person spending by school level for FY 2018.

To expand this analysis, I recommended in my February 7, 2018, memorandum that staff survey school principals after FY 2018 to gather feedback on the changes to the staff appreciation guidelines. With school opening now behind us, staff in the Internal Audit Unit will conduct this survey of principals in October 2018. The purpose of this survey is to gather feedback as to the adequacy of the current guideline calculation amount and any suggested amendments thereto. I will provide the Board an update on the results of this survey, as well as any recommendations on whether to adjust the guidelines for FY 2020.




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
