During Supplement A—Interim Superintendent's Recommendation for the Gaithersburg Cluster Elementary School #8 Boundary Study discussion, Mrs. Smondrowski requested the following information:

## **Question A**

Is there a possibility of having an option for rising grade 7 students to stay in their current schools for the continuity of their education and to assist with their mental well-being?

## Response

On November 18, 2021, the Board of Education approved the resolution for the Gaithersburg Elementary School #8 Boundary Study (Resolution No. 543-21). With respect to middle school students, while the adopted resolution included the grandfathering of rising grade 8 students, it did not include the grandfathering of rising Grade 7 students; therefore, in the 2022–2023 school year, the rising Grade 7 students who were reassigned as part of the adopted boundary study will need to relocate to their reassigned school. If a student desires to remain at their current school, the *Change of School Assignment* process would be required.

## **Question B**

Please provide data regarding the number of grade 7 students impacted in this boundary study.

## Response

There are approximately 100 Grade 7 students who will be impacted by the adopted boundary reassignment when the it is implemented in the 2022–2023 school year.
