Maryland Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association (MPSSAA) fall interscholastic athletic teams may begin practices on Wednesday, August 9, 2023. Though it is not mandatory that fall teams begin practice on August 9, all teams must begin practices by Saturday, August 12, 2023. Teams may distribute equipment on Tuesday, August 8, 2023.
