QUESTION:

How are other high schools with demographic profiles similar to Springbrook High School performing on the SAT?

ANSWER:

More than 60 percent of the students in the Springbrook High School Class of 2005 were African American (44.7 percent) or Hispanic (15.7 percent). The attached table presents SAT participation rates and average SAT combined verbal and math scores for students in the Montgomery County Public Schools Class of 2005 who attended any of the nine high schools where more than 45 percent of the students in the Class of 2005 were African American or Hispanic.
