ANSWER:

Below are the 20 elementary schools that do not have an assistant principal. The data is provided in order by projected enrollment for FY 2009. These are projected enrollments and may change. Allocations for elementary assistant principals are based on school enrollment, number of staff, and school needs. At this time, all but one focus school has an assistant principal and the immediate plan for FY 2009 will include that school. Although a final decision has not been made, if the ten positions are allocated to the ten largest schools that do not yet have an assistant principal, the schools that would receive an assistant principal would be Ritchie Park, Bradley Hills, Woodfield, Belmont, Darnestown, Poolesville, Somerset, Westbrook, Page, and Bannockburn elementary schools.
