

MCPS Retiree Class of 2022

Fact Sheet

797 employees have submitted their forms to retire from Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) for the 2022 school year and are included in this Board Resolution Report.

- The 797 employees are comprised of 44 administrators; 6 operations supervisors; 323 teacher professionals (both 10 and 12 months); and 424 support professionals.
- Of those 797 employees, 248 have served MCPS for 30 years or more, and 39 have served for 40 years or more.
- Of the 424 support professionals who retired during the 2022 school year, Mr. David Love, who retired on August 1, 2021, dedicated an incredible 56.3 years to our school system. MCPS must be like a second family to him! He worked as a building service manager III at Gaithersburg Middle School.
- Of the 323 teacher professionals, Ms. Wendy Eagan, who retired on July 1, 2022, built a successful 54-year career with MCPS. Ms. Eagan was a highly valued member of the Walt Whitman High School teaching staff, shaping the lives of countless students over five decades.
- Of the 44 administrators, Ms. Pamela DeFosse, who retired on July 1, 2022, contributed her invaluable expertise to our school system for 44.0 years. Ms. DeFosse was a supervisor with the Division of Special Education Pre-kindergarten, Programs and Services.
- Of the 6 operations supervisors, Mr. Dale Riner, who retired on January 1, 2022, committed his considerable time and talent to MCPS for 42.2 years. Mr. Riner was a logistics specialist with the Supply and Property Management Unit.
