Increasing Recycling Rates...one container at a time.



Great News! All elementary schools will start the new year by recycling the black plastic (PET Plastic #1) food containers. These containers can be placed in any commingled recycling receptacle.

Encourage students to tap the remaining food into a trash can, then students can stack the empty lunch containers on top of the recycle bin or drop them in a commingled container.

Make recycling fun by encouraging your students to tap and stack or tap and drop.

- Step 1: Tap your food into the trash.
- Step 2: Stack your tray for easy recycling.
- Step 3: Drop and recycle empty trays
