Questions To Ask College/University Representatives

Here are some questions that you may want to ask the college/university representatives at the college fair. Answers to these questions may help you decide if a school the right for you.

- 1. What sets your college/university apart from other colleges/universities?
- 2. What does your school consider for admissions? (activities, grades, SAT scores, etc.)
- 3. When are the enrollment deadlines? Do you have an early action or regular deadlines?
- 4. Can the enrollment fees be waived?
- 5. Do you require a certain SAT score?
- 6. What is the cost of your school annually? (i.e., tuition, room and board, etc.) be met?
- 7. What kind of financial aid does your school offer?
- 8. Does your school offer scholarships or grants for incoming students? How can I be considered?
- 9. What does your typical class size look like?
- 10. What are the most popular majors at your college/university?
- 11. What percentage of students return for their second year?
- 12. What percentage of your students go on to graduate school?
- 13. What percentage of students find employment after graduation?
- 14. Is your college located in an urban or suburban area?
- 15. Do you offer student housing, if so, for how long?
- 16. Can you tell me about the safety history of the college and possible the community it is in?
- 17. What type of student organizations and clubs are there for students?
- 18. What accommodations do you offer for students with physical disabilities or learning differences?
