Session 9 LEARN: Deeper Understanding of UDL's Impact



Part of your role on the UDL PLC is to create mechanisms for infusing UDL throughout the school building. One of the most effective ways of helping teachers see "what's in it for me" is by specifically illustrating how changes with UDL can positively benefit a specific student. In this session, you are asked to take time to reflect on how a specific student has benefited from your UDL practices, share a story that illustrates this impact in words and at least one other medium, and have a rich dialogue about these stories.
