MCPS SUGGESTED ELEMENTARY READING CONTENT COURSE WORK TO MEET MSDE REQUIREMENTS

MSDE requires 12 semester hours in the content for regular and special education teachers **certified** at the early childhood and elementary levels regardless of assignment.

- Processes and Acquisition of Literacy—Explains the process of language development, including the impact of phonemic awareness, and how the brain responds to reading acquisition.
- Instruction of Literacy—Shows teachers how to use a balanced program of phonics, semantics, and syntactics in teaching reading.
- Materials for Teaching Literacy—Exposes teachers to a variety of texts to be used in their classes & explains strategies for selecting/evaluation materials.
- Assessment for Literacy—Shows teachers how to use state, local, and classroom reading assessment data to make ongoing instructional modifications.

 OR

Alternative to Completing Reading Course Work—Applicants or current certificate holders with certification in early childhood, elementary, or special education may test out of the reading requirement by meeting the qualifying score of 159 on the *Praxis II 5205 test, Teaching Reading: Elementary*. Renewal credits must be completed even if this option is chosen to fulfill the reading requirements.
