

MCPS DISTRICTWIDE BOUNDARY ANALYSIS

Phase II Engagement

The Districtwide Boundary Analysis is an initiative designed to provide a comprehensive assessment of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) boundaries by analyzing data related to **utilization, diversity, proximity, and assignment stability**.

Phase II engagement is centered around an Interactive Boundary Explorer tool to help residents and stakeholders take a deeper look at school boundaries. The process will engage as many county residents and stakeholders as possible in the use of the tool. Feedback will be gathered by survey and virtual public meetings.

Public feedback will be included in the final report and presented to the Board of Education to inform future planning on school boundaries.
