- Identify emotions
- Know personal strengths weaknesses
- Self-confidence

Self-Management

- Impulse control
- Stress management
- Persistence & motivation
- Goal setting

Responsible Decision Making

- Evaluate multiple options
- Ethical implications?
- Short and long term implications?

Relationship Skills

- Cooperation
- Willingness to seek and provide help
- Communication skills

Social Awareness

- Empathy
- Respect for others
- See others' perspectives



- 29% Supportive School Environment
- 83% Academic Gains
- 11% Average Test Score Gain
- 11% Average GPA increase

- Suspensions
- Truancy
- Substance Abuse

- Reflection




Curriculum 2.0 & SEL

- Journal from perspective of serf v. lord, South v. North, etc.
- Read book
- Explain consequences decisions, alternatives
- Art project reflecting character's feelings
- What challenges did person overcome?

Curriculum 2.0 & SEL

- Cooperative team games
 - Reflection





- Math facts, reading levels, BCRs
- Biographies
 - Success-over-time

Bringing It Home

- Model problem solving
- Model emotional regulation
- 3 good things
- Foster growth mindset
 - Strategy emphasis
- Goal setting



Bringing It Home

- Volunteer
- Learn new skills together
- Discuss Character Counts lessons from school
- Ask how kids are feeling
- Give choices, follow through





Bringing It Home

- Positive cognitive process
- Infuse restorative questions
- Own your choices
