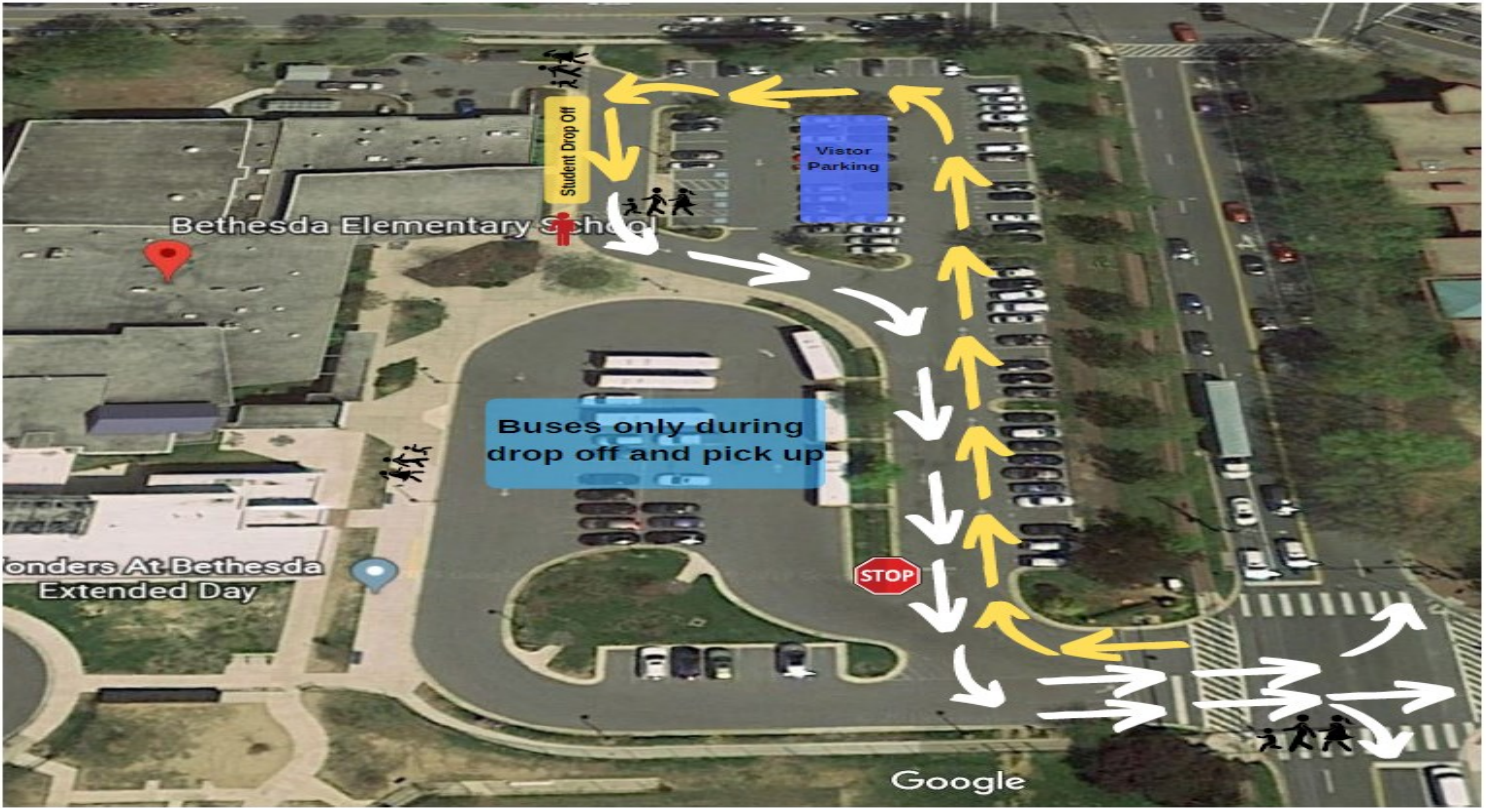

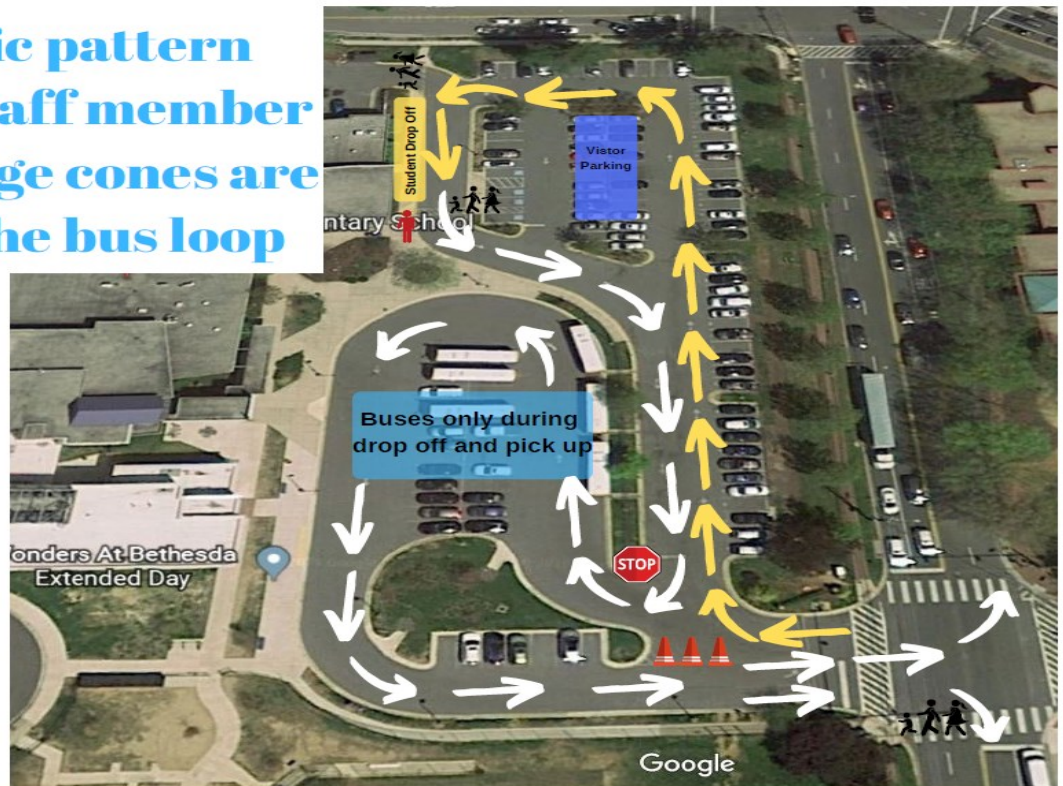
This is also a chance to purchase your BE Spirit Wear swag and information on PTA membership.

Arrival and Dismissal Traffic Patterns -

See pictures below for traffic flow. Please note that cars should ONLY use the bus loop to cut through when a staff member is directing OR the 3 cones are out. Drop off does NOT occur in the bus loop during arrival!

We are delighted that author Jessica Kensky will be visiting Bethesda Elementary School on October 1, 2019. She will discuss her picture book *Rescue and Jessica* with your children in grades 1-3.

Jessica is adjusting to life as an amputee. To help her accomplish everyday tasks she is assigned a service dog named Rescue. In addition to a helper, Jessica makes a new best friend. This story is based on real-life Boston Marathon survivor Jessica Kensky. When we first meet her, the book's pages are black and white, and full of dark corners. As Jessica and Rescue's friendship grows, color seeps back into the pages. While demystifying what it means to live with a disability, this book shows how service dogs can enable their disabled owners to live happy, colorful lives.

Books for this event will be distributed on October 1, but to facilitate signing we are offering the opportunity to PRE-ORDER books online. **The price reflects a 20% discount and sales tax is included.** You must follow the instructions below when ordering online to ensure your child receives their book.

Select the Connecticut Ave location. **Please note that books will be picked up and distributed by the school after the event; you don't have to come to the store!**

Checkout and complete payment. Review and submit order.

Please only purchase event books this way. If you have other online Politics and Prose shopping to do, please do so in a separate transaction.

Orders must be placed by September 17. Late orders cannot be accommodated.
