Good evening Candlewood Family-

Tomorrow, August 22, we welcome back our teachers to the school building, and on Wednesday the whole Candlewood staff will be back together! This will be an exciting week at Candlewood Elementary School as the staff prepares for your family's return. On Thursday, August 25 from 2:00-3:00pm, we will be welcoming your child(ren) back to the building for our annual Open House! Feel free to drop by for any amount of time between 2:00 - 3:00pm, but do know we will be ending promptly at 3:00 for a staff meeting. Links will be sent by each teacher if you would like to join virtually. During Open House, students and families will be able to meet their classroom teacher, see the classroom and walk around the building. Just a reminder, that this is not a time to have a meeting with your child's teacher. We do want you to share any information that you feel is important for your child's teacher to know prior to the first day, either via email or phone call.

We will have our **first Safety Patrol Meeting** of the school year for those 5th grade students who were selected to participate, which will be held at **1:30 pm in the media center, prior to the start of Open House.** Patrols, please do your best to attend in order to get important information about the first day of school and to receive your safety patrol belt.

(New) Back to School Night for Kindergarten and Extensions will also be this Thursday, August 25 at 6:30 pm. Grades first through fifth will have their Back to School Night on August 31 at 6:30pm. Kids Adventure will be providing free child care in the APR during both Back to School Night nights. Please note that our Back to School Nights are for parents only.

(New) Cafeteria News: MCPS will resume regular meal services during the 2022–2023 school year. Meal prices: Breakfast—\$1.30; Lunch—\$2.55 (Elementary), \$2.80 (Middle and High) Beginning this year, students in Maryland who qualify for reduced-price meals will not be charged for breakfast or lunch meals!

FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE MEAL APPLICATIONS: Apply online NOW so that benefits will be in place when school starts! Families who meet certain federal income standards are eligible for free or reduced price meal benefits. All children use their MCPS ID number at the register so confidentiality is maintained and no child is overtly identified as receiving free or reduced-price meals. Only one application is needed for all students in a household. A new application must be completed for any family requesting assistance this school year. (NEW) We have finalized our plan for the lunch time schedule that will provide students the opportunity to eat outside, weather permitting. ### **Lunch/Recess Schedule:**

We also would like to provide clarity on why there is a reduction of ten minutes for recess this year. At the end of the school year we received updated staffing allocations, which was directly due to a reduction of 60 students over the past two school years. Please note, while COVID staffing was not being reduced, we were actually considered "overstaffed" with additional classroom monitors and paraeducator hours. Please know that we always have the whole child in mind when making decisions, as a school and we are working as a school to ensure that students have brain breaks, and unstructured time to just be kids.

**ATTENDANCE:** Daily, consistent attendance at school equates with school success. We urge students and parents to make school a priority and to schedule vacations around the school calendar. A dated note, stating the specific reason for an absence, signed by a parent or guardian, is required no later than one day following an absence. Excused absences from school include: illness, doctor or dentist appointment, death in the immediate family, observance of a religious holiday, or a court order. It is important that students are on time to maximize instructional time.

Students who arrive late to school (after 9:00 AM) are expected to be signed in by a parent using the QR code at the front door of the building. Students are expected to have a written excuse for tardiness from the parent or legal guardian. Students must have a tardy slip from the office. If a student arrives in the classroom without one, teachers are expected to send him/her back to the office to be signed in.

Students who need to leave school during the day must bring a written excuse to the main office in the morning for approval. The parent must sign the student out when they leave school, and sign in when they return to school. If a student needs to be dismissed early, the parent should report to the office to pick up his/her child. We also know that there may be times that you need to pick up your child(ren) without prior

notice, please call the office at 301-284-4200, so we can have your child(ren) ready for you upon your arrival.

**First Day of School Information:** We are asking that students arrive at school the same way they are going home, unless they are going to an afterschool program. We have found that this limits confusion and students receive the proper identification, such as a red tag for riding the red bus when they arrive in the morning. We truly appreciate your support in starting the school year off successfully.

If your family is new to Candlewood Elementary School, please join us at 9am in the APR for a **New Parent Meet and Greet.** This will be an opportunity for you to meet other new parents and the administrative team.

- Dismissal begins at 3:23 pm for walkers
- Early dismissal at 12:55 pm

**Volunteering at Candlewood ES:** MCPS and Candlewood ES value the volunteers who work in our schools to enrich our students' experiences. As a community, we are mindful of our shared responsibility to create safe, nurturing environments for our students. This training provides guidance for volunteers to help keep students safe. Candlewood is looking forward to welcoming volunteers back to the building, please note that we are awaiting additional guidance from MCPS on when we can have volunteers back in the classrooms.

**Bicycles at School:** We have a bike rack at school that can fit up to 10 bikes. Students may ride a bicycle to school. A lock is needed in order to properly secure the bike to our rack. The school cannot assume responsibility for damaged or stolen bicycles. It is important that parents review bicycle safety and etiquette. Bicycles are to be "walked" on school property. Please remember that Montgomery County law requires that all children 18 years of age or younger wear bicycle helmets.

**Birthday Celebrations During the School Day:** Due to a growing variety of food allergies, edible birthday treats are not allowed for distribution at lunch/school. The school/main office will gift the students with a birthday pencil and receive a public "shout out" on or close to their special day. Parents that wish to send in a non-edible treat that the teacher could easily hand out in class, such as pencils or stickers, for the other students to celebrate their child's birthday, it would certainly be welcome. Candlewood Elementary wants to celebrate students' special days while we also ensure the safety and well-being of <u>all</u> students during the school day.

Seasonal Roots: Candlewood Elementary School is collaborating with Seasonal Roots to bring healthy, delicious food to our community, to support local farmers and artisans, and to raise money to support programs for Candlewood students. The donations will be designated to having school enrichment opportunities, building our media center collection and well-being support, etc.

**Seasonal Roots** is an online farmers market that delivers "dirt to doorstep" to families in Maryland and Virginia. Each week the market offers more than 150 items that are all grown and produced locally, sustainably, and ethically. Market items include fruit, vegetables, meat, dairy, baked goods, prepared foods, vegan specialties and more.

To access the Seasonal Roots market, you sign-up as a member and pay an annual membership fee. Through our collaboration, the fee is reduced by 50% - it's just \$25. For each Candlewood family that joins, the school receives \$20!

Once you are a member, what you order and when you order are up to you! There is no obligation. You can select exactly what produce and extras you want, skip or pause weekly deliveries, and cancel anytime.

The market opens Friday at 2:00PM and closes at midnight on Sunday. Orders are delivered on Wednesdays in Montgomery County.
