

Student Arrival Procedures

Cannon Road's student hours will be from 9:25 a.m. – 3:50 p.m. each regular school day with doors opening at 9:10 a.m. Our arrival procedures remain the same as last year. Walkers and car riders will be entering the building using the long sidewalk at the front of the school that takes you to a set of brown doors at the end of the sidewalk. As students arrive, they are expected to walk directly to their classrooms, get breakfast if they choose, and begin their day. It is very important that your child arrives on time and prepared for the instructional day. Also, it is imperative that students DO NOT arrive prior to 9:10, as supervision is not available. For their safety, any students who arrive after 9:25 will follow tardy arrival procedures. Please call the school office at 240-740-0520 and someone will come out to meet your child at the front of the school.

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Student Dismissal Procedures

We will start the dismissal procedures daily at 3:50 p.m. Our dismissal procedures are the same as the previous year. Families who are car riders will wait for their child in our car rider loop. Families who are walkers are asked to park on the street (if applicable) and meet their child on the field (tennis court) side of the building. Please make sure to communicate your dismissal plan with your child's teacher. If you plan to pick your child up for an early dismissal or change their dismissal plans, please contact the school by no later than 3:00 p.m. to make the appropriate arrangements or to have your child escorted out to you by staff for an early dismissal.

Transportation

Each year, the Department of Transportation reviews all bus routes to assure safety, fairness and equity of service, efficiency, and adherence to local policy and state laws. The bus schedule for students in regular programs is located on our <u>website</u>.

School Breakfast and Lunch

All students will receive a free breakfast and lunch as part of the Community Eligibility Provision School. Students will have the opportunity to get a free breakfast and lunch. However, students are also more than welcome to bring a bagged lunch from home.
