It has been a busy month as we learn small reading and math group routines. We look forward to continuing our learning!

Reading

Kindergarten students are reading informational text to ask and answer questions. Students are identifying the front cover, title page, and back cover of a book.

Math

Students are counting a group of objects in a line, circle, or array and representing the amount in written form. We are learning to use strategies to accurately count from 1 to 20. We are counting and comparing the length of two quantities.

Science and Social Studies

We are learning about plant life cycles and plant features.



In Social Studies, we are identifying landforms as well as physical and human-made features.

- Play board games with your child to practice taking turns.
- Have your child practice counting 1-30 and writing numbers 11-20.
- Give your child plenty of opportunities for outdoor play: running, jumping, and climbing.
