Here is an overview of the topics that will be covered in the month of April.

## Reading

Kindergarten students are reading informational text to identify the main topic and key details. We are reading literary text to ask and answer questions and retell stories.

## Math

We are representing addition and subtraction problems within 10 with objects, fingers, and drawings. We are practicing ordinal numbers (first – tenth), and writing number 0-20 to represent a set.

## Science and Social Studies



In science, we are comparing and contrasting animals' external features and adaptations



In Social Studies, we are identifying situations where people make choices to meet their needs and wants.

## Suggestions for Success

- Have your child read to you or read a book to your child every day!
- Have your child recite their home address and phone number.
