This month will be fun filled with our 100th day of school celebration and our Valentine's Day Celebration!

Reading

Kindergarten students will be reading literary text. They will retell familiar stories. They will also begin to compare and contrast the adventures of the characters in the story. They will learn the different elements of a story.

Math

We will begin to decompose numbers up to 10 and break it into two parts. We will discover and compare 2 dimension shapes with familiar objects. We will identify a triangle, square, circle and rectangles. Students will be able to identify the number of sides and corners of each shape.

Science and Social Studies



We will discover plants and animals their external features (fur, shell, feathers and scales) and how they use them for survival.



In Social Studies, we are exploring jobs and services they provide such as a doctor, dentist, police officer or a fire fighter.

- Practice writing their first and last name using Upper and Lowercase letters.
