## READ ACROSS AMERICA DAY

### Reading

Kindergarten students are reading informational text to ask and answer questions about key details and unknown words in a text and to identify the main topic and retell key details.

### Math

We are practicing identifying whether the number of objects in one group is greater than, less than, or equal to the number of objects in another group, decomposing numbers up to 10 into two parts, and representing addition and subtraction with objects, fingers, and drawings.

### Science and Social Studies



In science, we are learning how animals use their external features to survive.



In Social Studies, we are identifying situations where people make choices to meet their needs and wants.
