Principally Speaking: "Returning to School"

Unfortunately, our children are being bombarded by uncivil actions and conversations happening around them on a daily basis. As we turn on the television, listen to the news, engage with social media networks, students hear adults or their classmates being uncivil to one another. The sad news is that our students may begin to believe this works, or that the biggest bully or the rudest person endures no negative consequence or actually benefits from their uncivil actions.

According to the dictionary, civility is formal politeness or courtesy in behavior or speech. Civility is recognizing the humanity of others and putting the common good above your own self interest. Yes, civility is showing restraint, treating people with respect and listening to others who have a different opinion without being rude. It is up to all of us to let our children know that civility to one another is a choice that should be made if we are to live peacefully with one another.

Try these tips on teaching children civility:

- ◆ Teach manners-children who learn to say please, thank you, excuse me, I'm sorry, create a positive environment around them. A major part of civility is politeness.
- ◆ Model tolerance and acceptance-teach children to accept people who are different. Showing respect for different cultures helps destroy stereotypes and increases a positive environment.
- ◆ Apologize often-our children understand that an apology does not make them weak or powerless, but shows that we care about someone else's feelings.
- ◆ Encourage empathy-when children consider the feelings of others, they are showing empathy. Ask them how they think another person feels in situations and discuss it.
- ◆ Serve the community-help children find things they can do to help in their community. The feelings of pride and accomplishment children feel when they know their actions make a difference and helps others. Let them know that this is what good citizens do.

Finally, you must practice what you preach. Let children see you being civil even when others are not. Show them that you know how to disagree, but not be disagreeable. Everyday there are multiple opportunities for us to model civility for our children.


