**VOLUNTARY PARENT DONATIONS (ALL CLASSES):**

**KINDERGARTEN**

- \* 1 Large backpack, no wheels

- \* Crayons, 24/box, (Crayola preferred) (Students typically use 3-24 pc boxes per year)
- \* 1 Green composition book, hard cover, 100 pg
- \* 1 Box markers, thin or wide line (Crayola preferred)
- \* 1 Red composition book, hard cover, 100 pg
- \* 1 Black composition book, hard cover 100 pg
- \* 1 Plastic pencil box
- \* 1 Scissors, 5", blunt tip
- \* 1 Pocket folder, sturdy, plastic-coated

**FIRST GRADE**

- \* Child scissors (rounded edges)
- \* 2 Composition book
- \* 1 Box crayons, 24 pack (Crayola preferred)
- \* 3-6 Glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)
- \* Pencil box, plastic

**VOLUNTARY PARENT DONATIONS:** Snack, gallon and sandwich size bags (Ex...Ziploc), baby wipes, tissues, 8 pack of markers (thick & thin - Crayola preferred)

**SECOND GRADE**

- \* 2-inch binder-metal 3-ring (no zippers)
- \* 5 (black and white marble) wide ruled composition books
- \* Loose leaf notebook paper (wide-lined)
- \* Eraser caps/oblong eraser
- \* 1 Ruler (inches & centimeters) for home use
- \* #2 pencils (not mechanical)
- \* 5 Tabbed dividers – (Labelled Writing, Math, Reading, Science, and Social Studies)
- \* Three-holed pencil case for binder w/ zipper
- \* Large backpack

#### **FIFTH GRADE:**

- \* 3-inch three-ringed binder
- \* Three-holed pencil case with zipper
- \* Wide-ruled lined notebook paper
- \* 5 Loose-leaf subject dividers labelled: Math, Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies, and Spelling
- \* 3 Hardcover 100-page composition notebooks
- \* 1 doz #2 (non-mechanical) pencils (sharpened preferred)
- \* 3 One subject, spiral notebooks
- \* Colored pencils (sharpened preferred)
- \* 1 set of ear buds
