English Language Arts/Social Studies

This month, in ELA, our students will be working on the following standards and skills:

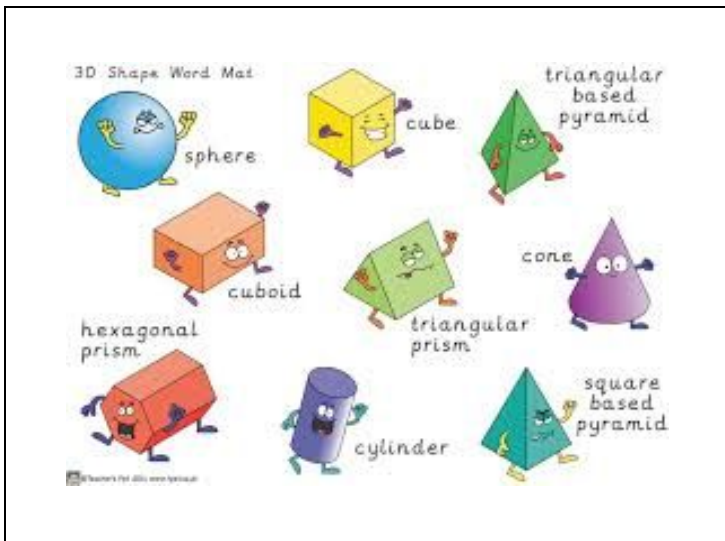
- Use consonant digraphs (-sh, -ch, -th) and blends (bl-, cl-, fl-) in speaking, reading and writing.
- Discuss and use before, during, and after reading strategies such as a picture walk, sounding out, finding known or unknown words, and rereading.
- Identify the main topic of an informational text and the key details that support the main topic
- Retell key details of literary texts using story maps and other graphic organizers
- Identify goods and services and the people that provide them
- Participate in large and small groups to read, discuss, compare and comprehend informational texts.



Math/Science

This month, in math, we will be working on the following standards:

- Describe and compare attributes of 2 dimensional and 3 dimensional shapes
- Identify whether a number is greater than or less than another number
- Represent numbers in a variety of ways, including tens and ones blocks
- Identify the different animal coverings and the way they help the animal
- Observe and discuss the mealworms
