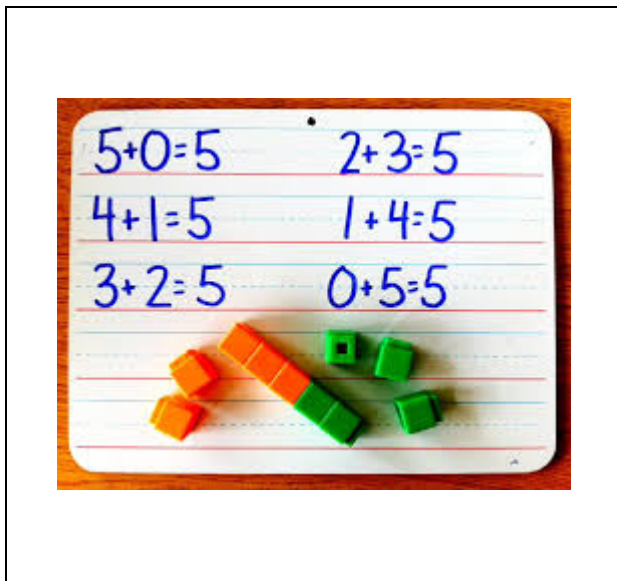
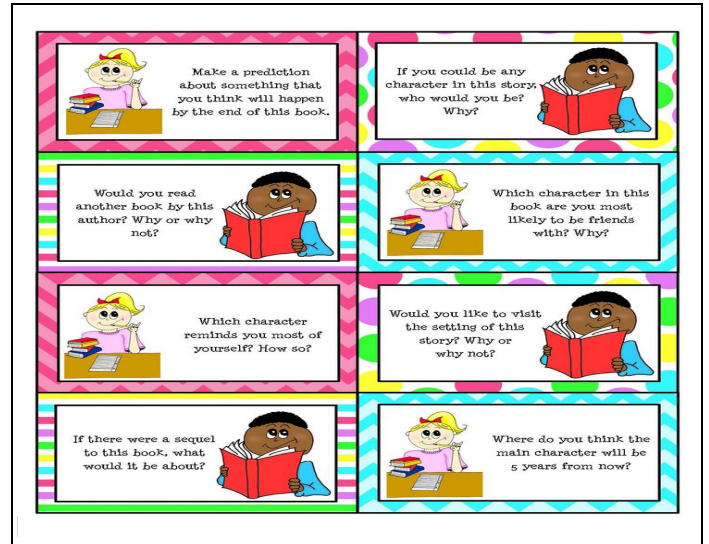


# EAGLE NEWS - KINDERGARTEN

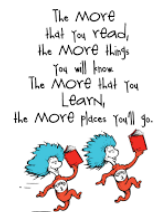
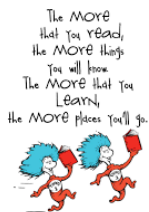
## English Language Arts/Social Studies
