Literacy

This month, in literacy, we are beginning the theme: Our Community. The students will be learning to demonstrate an understanding of the parts of a book and basic features of print. They will learn to recognize upper and lowercase letters of the alphabet and letter sounds. Our goal is for all students to be able to identify all 52 letters and 26 letter sounds. We

will start using level 1 texts to work on left to right progression, identify one letter and one word, two letters and two words, sentences, and picture support.

Math

This month, in math, the students will identify written numerals 0-10 and move forward to 20, 50 and 100. They will verbally count to 10 by ones and then develop rote counting to 20, 50, and 100 by ones. Our goal is to have all students count to 10/20/50/100 and identify all the



numerals from 1-10/20/50/100. Students will also be identifying simple shapes, sorting, measuring and comparing lengths. They will also be introduced to more/less, simple maps, comparing distances, and position words.
