Literacy

This month, in literacy, we are studying the theme: Awesome Animals. The students will be learning to demonstrate an understanding of basic features of print. They will learn to recognize upper and lower case letters of the alphabet and letter sounds. Our goal is for all students to be able to identify all 52 letters and their

sounds. They will begin to identify words in a sentence by using snap cubes as each word is said in the sentence. The students who have mastered naming 52 letters and 26 letter sounds are working in guided reading groups.

Math

This month, in math, the students will identify written numerals 0-10. They will verbally count to 10 by ones and then develop rote counting to 20 by ones. Our goal is to have all students count to 10 and identify all the numerals from 1-10. Students will also be identifying simple shapes, sorting, measuring and comparing lengths. Our goal is to have all students count from 1 to 100 and identifying numerals 1-100. The students who have mastered counting to 100 are working on addition.
