## Math Focus

We are wrapping up Module 2 where students will explore measurement using units of kilograms, grams, liters, milliliters, and intervals of time in minutes. We will begin Module 3 the third week of November. Module 3 builds directly on students' work with multiplication and division in Module 1. Module 3 extends the study of factors from 2, 3, 4, 5, and 10 to include all units from 0 to 10, as well as multiples of 10 within 100.

## **Reading and Writing Focus**

Students will start working on Unit 2: Ways Characters Shape Stories. Students are working toward answering the Essential Question, how do our actions influences our lives? In this unit, students will read and compare stories, poems, and myths to analyze characters and understand how their actions shape events. In writing, students are writing a fable involving two characters, with a problem, solution, and a moral (lesson learned).

## Science and Social Studies Focus

We will be doing Social Studies during the month of November. Students will work through two modules. In Module 1, students will learn about different geographic features of the land using features and regions of Maryland. In Module 2, students will learn about multiple perspectives of decision-making to protect/modify the environment.
