Guidelines for Adjusting the Elementary Continuity of Learning Schedule

The schedule reflects general times but can be adjusted to meet the needs of the schools and staff. In making adjustments to the schedule, please keep in mind the following:

- All "live" elementary mathematics and literacy sessions should occur in the morning before lunch. This will allow secondary students who share computers with younger siblings to have the opportunity to meet with their teachers in the afternoon.
- A student **lunch break** must occur between 11:00-1:00 pm (or as close as possible) to provide time for students who will need to go to an MCPS Food Distribution Site.
- All elementary students should have mathematics on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- All elementary students should have literacy on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- All elementary **ESOL** students have Eureka ELD lessons on Monday and the Benchmark ELD lesson on Wednesday.
- All students should use the Eureka Mathematics and Benchmark curriculum. The following are exceptions:
 - French and Chinese Immersion
 - Enriched Literacy Curriculum
 - Centers for Enriched Studies
- All students with IEPs should have scheduled times with case managers and special education teachers and/or
 paraeducators to work on IEP goals and receive instructional support. Your Special Educators and service providers will be
 receiving additional information from the Office of Special Education containing additional guidance regarding roles and
 responsibilities for IEP meetings, case management and providing support and services for students with disabilities.
- All students with **504s** must be contacted by the counselor to ensure accommodations are being provided.
- All **ESOL** teachers should preview all mathematics, literacy, and English Language Development (ELD) resources that their students will access. They can arrange to meet with the classroom teacher and their students during their debrief of the lessons and provide ELD instruction and/or provide individualized ELD during the office hour time.
- Elementary schools should make every effort to schedule specials every other week by grade level for 40-60 minutes.
- The continuation of **departmentalization** is possible and should be discussed with the Instructional Leadership Team. Please consider the following:
 - A teacher may have one large "live" session with students in multiple classes
