#### Notes from Your Counselor......Gloria Silverberg

For the last few weeks in class counseling, we have been talking about how to recognize and express big feelings. Challenging behaviors occur most often when children cannot figure out how to express their feelings. We can help them by recognizing those feelings and helping to teach them in a positive way.



• **Books** can be a great way to help children learn about emotions. When reading together, point out the different feelings the characters are expressing,

- Remind children to use their words to express themselves, rather than an action or a misbehavior. Labeling a feeling is a step toward greater maturity and selfcontrol. An example is: "I'm frustrated, can you please help me?"
- Provide empathy. Often all that is needed to soothe a child, is to know they are being heard and understood. It is also a great way to model using words instead of actions to express big emotions.
- After the strongest feelings are gone, *help children move on*. Take a few deep *mindful breaths* together and do a big whole *body stretch*. Then suggest a new activity or even a little *humor*. Being able to move on is teaching children *resilience*.

Communication Skills are another skill area we are learning about. Using "I statements", such as "I feel \_\_\_\_\_, when you \_\_\_\_\_\_. I would like you to \_\_\_\_\_."
