#### **Inclement Weather Procedures:**

As we approach the winter weather season, it is important to note that there may be some weather conditions that may cause interruption to the school day. The best way to be informed of these interruptions would be to listen to your radio and/or TV news stations. You may also turn to Channel 34/Comcast or Channel 36/Verizon. The most up to date information will be found on these MCPS Channels. Every effort will be made to **announce closings/delayed openings by 5:00 AM** before the school day begins. In the case of delayed opening, school will begin two hours late. Bus transportation will follow the same two-hour delay schedule. All AM Pre-K, Head Start and half day programs will be cancelled. Field Trips will also be cancelled.

If the inclement weather begins during the school day and an Early Dismissal is necessary, an announcement will be made by **11:00 AM**. Schools will dismiss **two and a half hours** early. All PM Pre-K, Head Start, and afternoon half-day programs will be cancelled.
