

Grading and Reporting

It is a comprehensive system that:

aligns instruction and assessment to standards

aligns grades to grade-level standards



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Grading and Reporting

Standards-based teaching and learning:

 links instruction and grading to standards; and

 provides an accurate reflection of what students know and are able to do.



Standards-based Report Card

"A standards-based report card or reporting tool must clearly describe what students are expected to know and be able to do.

A standards-based report card or reporting tool must clearly describe a student's level of knowledge and performance of the standards."

Elementary Report Card - Purpose


Written record of student performance on curriculum outcomes over time:

- communicates student performance with parents;
- provides information to move students to the next grade level; and
- indicates readiness, progress or successful transition.

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




