Ms. Bailey. Welcome 1st PTA meeting; past few months working w/ PTA on the needs
of the school; Security cameras fully installed in school and can view/review at any

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time; concerns of staff-training-safety and security training-2 shelter in places-children were able to follow direction-remind students that they must follow instruction of teacher; earthquake drill Great Shake Down;; professional teaching staff fully-staffed; meet and greet w/ Mr. Gray since he started 10.02.2023; 10/09: Professional development on anti-racism county-wide (no school for students) focus on EML students and how teachers can support them in the classroom; academic-MAP in math and reading K-2; 10/11/2023 Grade 4-5 teachers-town hall re expectations and motivate to have a trusted adult; school expectations (three R's - Respect, Responsibility, Ready); like a pep rally and est positive relationship with the school; scored low on the survey; Class Dojo (can be translated), synergy messages from OB to ensure she gets what is going on in the school; MCPS uses Remind-another tool that will likely replace how teachers communicate since it can be translated; Harmony SEL new curriculum to build community (morning meetings-work on comm and how they express themselves; teachers should be sharing w/ you what they are learning and what they are focusing on; parent volunteers-teachers set expectations.: Allie Orta suggested that there is standard communication; OB confirmed that is expectation to do regular communication.
