IV. Treasurer's Update

Julie reported that \$ 23,313.21 was raised so far this year and \$13,600.98 has been disbursed. The balance as of February 1, 2017 is \$10,221.49. Teacher Reimbursements are currently \$1,689 and teachers have until Feb.15, 2017 to submit their receipts. Cultural Arts Assemblies \$1,535 and Fundraising costs were \$8,565. Box tops has raised \$112 in the first collection.

The carryover goal for this year is \$2,000. There was a suggestion to have a carryover for Cultural Arts as well as have the budget vot at the back to school picnic advertised better next year.
