Curriculum News

Our mathematicians will explore 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional shapes in November. We will learn how to correctly identify those shapes regardless of their orientation, size, or variation. We will classify and identify shapes using more precise descriptions based on mathematical attributes (For example, "It's a rectangle because it has four straight sides and no openings.").

In reading, we will exploring different characters in Unit 2. We will continue with rhyming, as well as segmenting and blending sounds. We will write about characters and retell story events using key details. Please encourage your child to make predictions, retell events or facts, and ask questions as you read together at home.

In social studies, we will explore maps and globes and learn to identify different physical features such as bodies of water and landforms. We will also look at manmade features including bridges and roads.

In our Leader in Me Lessons, we will continue to learning to lead ourselves by identifying and applying calming strategies, taking responsibility for our choices, prioritizing the things that matter most, personal mission statements. We can be proactive!
