New: Solar Eclipse

As you know, a solar eclipse is going to occur on Monday, April 8th. MCPS will be operating on a regular schedule for the day. Safety reminders and information regarding the eclipse for families can be found <u>HERE</u> and <u>HERE</u>.

Scientists have predicted that our eclipse will begin around 2:04 p.m., will reach its fullest potential around 3:20 p.m. which is our dismissal, and conclude by 4:32 p.m. Students and staff must avoid looking directly at the sun unless they are able to properly use <u>designated and</u> <u>approved eclipse viewing glasses</u>.

- The PTA and families have provided eclipse glasses for all of our students.
- We will remind students that they are not to look directly towards the sun and should travel home as they normally would.
- We ask that all parents reiterate with their children the safety concerns with staring at the eclipse and the harmful effects that it may have on their vision.
- As a school, we will not be hosting any whole school viewing events however individual classes may elect to do.
 - Some classes may go outside before dismissal, if you would prefer that your child not go outside to view the eclipse before dismissal, please notify your child's homeroom teacher no later than Monday, April 8th by 1:00pm.
 - If we do not hear from you and your child's class is going outside before dismissal they will be part of the experience.
