Please be aware of the new MCPS policy for *long term absences*. If a student is absent for ten days or more, they need to be withdrawn from school. Upon the families return, they will need to submit proof of residency to the main office before the student can be re-enrolled. Every effort

will be made to return the student to their previously assigned classroom, but re-enrollment will be based on class numbers and students being assigned to their previous classroom is not guaranteed. Advanced notice to teachers and Mrs. Cardea of long term absences is appreciated.
