FICTION



What does the author want me to think about?

What is the author's purpose? Is it clear?

Choose a character's point of view in a story. Do you agree with the character's point of view? Explain.

What inferences can you make about the characters, problem, or solution?

What changes would you make to the story?



NONFICTION



What claim, problems, or issues is the author addressing?

What evidence supports the claim, problems, or issues?

What does the author want you to think about?

What inferences can be made from the facts of evidence?

What is the author's point of view?
