11/13/20	Test registration due. Registration can occur after this date but College Board charges a \$40 late fee. DO NOT email Linda Schaus without first reading the message at the bottom of the page and following those directions. ****
01/15/21	Request for financial assistance to pay for AP exams due. Please fill out the google form. https://forms.gle/tvghJ9GfBYNTTpJM6
01/15/21	Requests for accommodations must be submitted to College Board. Contact your guidance counselor or case manager about receiving accommodations.
Late January 2021	College Board will make a decision about whether to have in-person exams, on-line exams, or a hybrid.
Late January 2021	AP Coordinator will send out information on how to pay for AP exams. Information will be posted on the BCC website and sent through Synergy (ParentVue) email to AP students and their parents. This was delayed until after College Board makes their decision about in-person versus on-line exams. We understand that this could impact students' decision to take exams. The exam fee is \$95 per exam.
