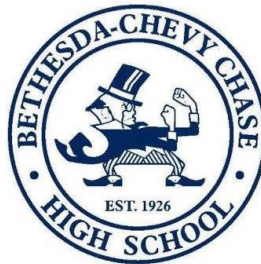
Dr. Mooney's Message

Last Wednesday, we evacuated the building after a sprinkler in a third floor Science classroom activated and set off the fire alarm. The initial response from students and staff to the alarm was an appropriate evacuation from the building. Unfortunately, within in moments of the fire department allowing us to return to the building, the fire alarm activated a second time and we evacuated again. We were able to reenter the building again just before dismissal.

As I have reflected on Wednesday's events, I would like to share a few reminders about B-CC's safety and evacuation procedures.

- 📍 All students are expected to remain with their assigned class and teacher during all emergency events. This allows us to account for students and communicate effectively with emergency responders.
- 📍 Dismissal times will rarely be changed and any such decisions will be widely communicated with parents. Otherwise, students should remain on campus.
