Barons Crush Cancer updates

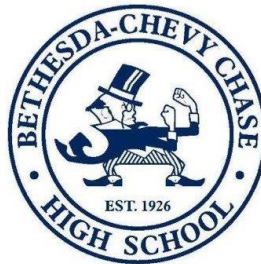
- We've raised \$13,000 so far, but we still need your help to reach our \$20,000 goal. [Donate here!](#)
