 - o Explain job responsibilities, required skills and possible career paths
 - o Discuss and support students' job interests and education/career goals
- Provide lunch for student participants

WHAT DOES IT TAKE?

- Prepare for worksite visit by reviewing dress code and conduct standards and by conducting background research on host site

- Attend one of two required information sessions at B-CC on November 28 or 29 at lunch in the Choral Room
- Make transportation arrangements to worksite
- Attend required debrief session on December 2 at lunch in the Choral Room
- Complete evaluation form
- Submit thank you note to hosts
