She Kills Monsters tells the story of high schooler Agnes Evans as she deals with the death of her younger sister, Tilly.

When Agnes stumbles upon Tilly's Dungeons & Dragons notebook, she finds herself catapulted into a journey of discovery and action-packed adventure in the imaginary world that was her sister's refuge.

In this high-octane dramatic comedy laden with homicidal fairies, nasty ogres, and '90s pop culture, acclaimed playwright Qui Nguyen offers a heart-pounding homage to the geek and warrior within us all.

Director's Notes

Loss, grief, separation, anger, understanding — these are just a few of the feelings that swirl through the storyline of *She Kills Monsters*. Any good play seeks connection to the audience, and SKM delivers on that promise. In today's world, as the lines between reality and fantasy increasingly overlap, SKM pays tribute to the Dungeons & Dragons phenomenon that has extended and evolved right up to the present day.

Some of you grew up playing D&D as kids. Most of us have at least heard of the game. Together with the growth of cosplay (costume play) into a global phenomenon, it's encouraging to consider that for millions of people, immersion into other worlds and other characters isn't just a way to spend time with friends; it's a way to explore our humanity across a complex universe of creatures, lords, demons, knights, bounty hunters, heroes, goblins, and monsters.

In playing these games, our moral compasses are somehow hammered into firmer shape. They're made more definable, even in the heat of battle and crossing swords. People crave connection. And when loved ones are lost, the search for answers can happen in the most unlikely of places. Our Magruder Drama students, onstage and off, have made these characters come fully to life. About the Playwright

Qui Nguyen is a screenwriter, director, playwright and Co-Founder of the OBIE-winning Vampire Cowboys, often credited as a pioneer of “geek theatre” and the first and currently only professional theatre organization to be officially sponsored by NY Comic Con. He is known for his use of pop-culture in his work, as well as stage violence, puppetry, and multimedia. Qui is currently working with Walt Disney Animation Studios where he wrote *Raya and the Last Dragon* and wrote/co-directed *Strange World*. Other TV/Film includes *Dispatches from Elsewhere* (AMC), *The Society* (Netflix), *Incorporated* (SyFy), *Peg+CAT* (PBS) and *Marvel Studios*. As a playwright, notable plays include *Vietgone*, *Poor Yella Rednecks*, *Revenge Song*, and the critically acclaimed Vampire Cowboy productions of *She Kills Monsters*, *Soul Samurai*, *The Inexplicable Redemption of Agent G*, *Alice in Slasherland*, *Fight Girl Battle World*, and *Living Dead in Denmark*. Currently, Qui is developing new plays with *Manhattan Theater Club/Geffen Playhouse*, *The Atlantic*, *Cincinnati Playhouse in the Park*, and *Center Theatre Group/The Goodman*.

DISCLAIMER: Parts of this production include dramaturgy of homophobic actions and phrases. We acknowledge fully that the depiction of such actions can be emotionally challenging and harmful. We have altered certain derogatory words chosen by the playwright for ones that have been reclaimed by the LGBTQIA+ community. These reclaimed words were at one point considered offensive but have now been accepted and reappropriated, usually by the target community. Rather than removing these elements, these changes are in an effort to convey and educate the audience about the real battles people within the community have faced and overcome, and to work towards ending these painful prejudices. Magruder Drama and the drama community at large are committed to creating a safe, protected and inclusive environment to explore these complex topics.




CAST/CREW BIOS
