

# **A Typical Week**



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- ➤ Physical Fitness Training 3 mornings per week, before classes start
- ➤ One classroom session per week
- ➤ One Leadership Lab per week

8 Hours per week

- ➤ Part of the Cadet Battalion. You learn leadership by being assigned a leadership position. This requires additional time outside scheduled training.
- ➤ When not in scheduled ROTC training you are a regular college student not in uniform, able to participate fully in college life.

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

## The Scholarship Interview



- Interview is a subjective evaluation of your leadership potential
- Keys to a successful interview:
  - · Appearance: Dress well
  - Composure: Maintain eye contact, good posture, be confident
  - Communication: Hold a conversation, ask questions, avoid one sentence answers
  - Motivation:
    - Convey your reason for being an Army Officer
    - · Avoid selfish or mercenary attitudes
    - Relate what you have done to Leadership

- >Fully Automated www.goarmy.com
- ➤ 3 Deadlines: October, December, March
- ➤ 12,000 Applicants 2,000 selected
