Not to be confused with Memorial Day, which honors those who died while in service, Veterans Day honors all military veterans, including those still with us.

Did you know that According to the National Museum of the American Indian, 44,000 of their estimated population of nearly 400,000 saw active duty in the war. They included the famed Navajo Code Talkers, who used traditional language to transmit messages that could not be interpreted by the enemy. Another was Marine Corporal Ira Hamilton Hayes, who helped raise the American flag on Mount Suribachi during the Battle of Iwo Jima. That was our moment in Native American History.
