

ON-THE-SPOT ADMISSIONS

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



1. ***What are on-the-spot admissions?***

They are local events for students to apply for admission to select colleges, face-to-face, and get an immediate acceptance decision.

2. ***Who can apply?***

ANY senior may participate in an on-the-spot admissions event.

3. ***When and where are they held?***

On-the-spot admissions events happen locally throughout the school year, typically September – March. They are usually held at area high schools, during the day or in the evening.

4. ***How do I find out about them?***

Students should listen for announcements, check the Family Connection website, the MCPS website and see Mrs. Maloney in the College & Career Center for information.

5. ***What do I need to do to apply?***

Students should have their completed college application, their resume, a sealed copy of their transcript and letter(s) of recommendation, and their SAT/ACT scores. Dress to impress!

6. ***What else do I need to know?***

See your counselor or Mrs. Maloney in the College & Career Center for specific college information, transportation options, and additional details. Note: Scholarships may be awarded on-the-spot but may have higher requirements.
