**Apply – Students can still apply to MC for FREE! If possible, please continue to encourage students to apply before April 15** (No word yet on an extension.)

- **Activate Your Account and Determine Placement** – All in-person testing services at the college is suspended indefinitely, however we are encouraging students to use this time to prepare for the ACCUPLACER/ALEKS and have provided resources. Students that have taken an SAT/ACT can continue to send scores electronically via College Board. As I receive more information about other options for sending SAT/ACT scores and submitting transcripts for the APPG placement exemption, I will continue to share updates with you.

- **Complete Your Orientation and Schedule Appointment with an Advisor:** Students continue to receive communications that they can complete the mandatory orientation online.
